Clinical Work Process

Students are required to sign this agreement listing the following restrictions applying to compensation for work while students and faculty are utilizing the clinical sites for instructional objectives.

1. The time spent in the clinical area is by design an instructional exercise to provide the students with learning experiences that will expand their surgical technology knowledge base.
2. During the period of clinical instruction, the student will not be used as a substitute for any staff member regardless of the urgency of the work conditions.
3. Students who are paid employees of hospitals that are used as clinical sites will not be considered staff during their clinical rotations.
4. Students will not receive any type of payment for any services rendered while in the clinical area receiving clinical instruction.
5. Any faculty while serving in the capacity of clinical instructor at any clinical site will not receive any type of payment for services rendered during the course of the instructional day.
6. Any breach of the above stated guidelines may result in immediate suspension for the students and possible termination for faculty members.
