Everyone entering the Adult Education Program must be assessed. The Adult Education Waycross Campus conducts a monthly orientation and assessment for that purpose. The assessment is FREE. Students will be evaluated at these monthly Orientation and Assessment sessions. Students are then placed in a class based on availability and time preference. *All classes are free.*

ALL STUDENTS MUST HAVE A VALID STATE PICTURE ID BEFORE BEING ASSESSED.

ORIENTATION AND ASSESSMENT WILL BE CONDUCTED ON THE MAIN CAMPUS IN ROOM 210.

All students must attend the session in order to be placed in class or to determine GED readiness. Underage youth, ages 16 - 18 must have an official withdrawal form from the last school attended, and all students must present proof of residence (GA ID, Passport, etc.)
